## WEST CAPE HOWE RIESLING 2005

West Cape Howe is not yet 10 years old, making it a relatively new player on the West Australian wine scene, but it's already a significant one in quantity and quality. Riesling is a speciality in Western Australia's far south and this is a fine example. The aroma is delicate with fine floral and lime-lemon scents that give it a pure, tangy feel. The palate is clean and light but intense and penetrating with apple, citrus and spice flavours set against a backbone of acidity.

Excellent.

**Ageing?** Drink over six years.

**Food ideas:** Quick-fried calamari with lime, chilli and coriander; grilled fish.
